### News for Patients about Genitourinary Cancer Advances

Top bladder and prostate cancer news emerging from the 2010 Genitourinary Cancers Symposium includes a new drug that extends survival for men with advanced prostate cancer, a urine test that helps determine if a biopsy is needed for prostate cancer, evidence that hormone therapy plus radiation therapy benefits some men with early-stage prostate cancer, and data indicating that cystoscopy alone is the best way to monitor bladder cancer recurrence.

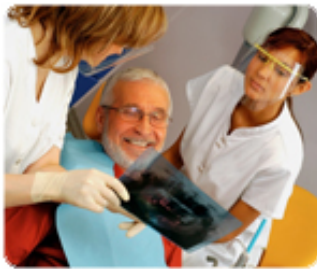
