Dr. Murali M. Chintagumpala is a Professor of Pediatrics, Clinical Director of the Neuro-Oncology Program, and the Director of the Solid Tumor Team at the Texas Children's Cancer Center, Baylor College of Medicine.

Dr. Chintagumpala earned his medical degree at Madras Medical College in Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India. After completing his residency program in pediatrics in Chicago, Illinois, Dr. Chintagumpala completed a fellowship in pediatric-hematology at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas and joined the faculty.

He is well known for his clinical expertise in pediatric brain tumors and solid tumors and has conducted several multi-institutional clinical trials for children with these tumors. Within the Children's Oncology Group (COG), he is the chairman of the Retinoblastoma Committee and a member of the Brain Tumor and Renal Tumor committees. He represents his institution as the principal investigator within the Pediatric Brain Tumor Consortium (PBTC).
